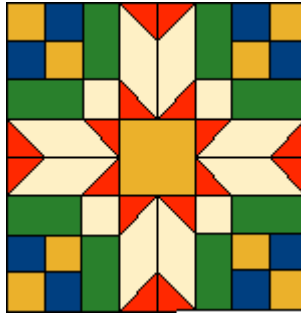


Block of the Month – Blackford's Beauty 2004



Cutting Instructions:

From Background Fabric: Cut 8- 2" x 5" rectangles, cut 4- 2" squares.

From Red Fabric: Cut 16- 2" squares.

From Green Fabric: Cut 8- 2" x 3" rectangles.

From Navy Fabric: Cut 1 strip 2" x 17".

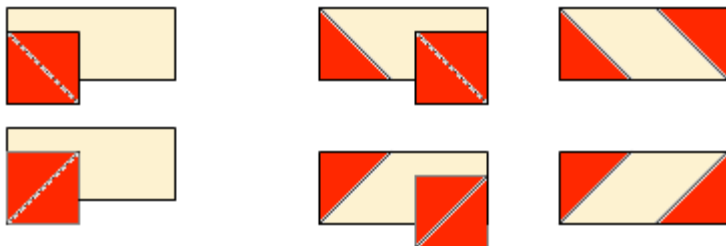
From Gold Fabric: Cut 1 strip 2" x 17", Cut 1- 3" square.

Sew the 2" x 17" strips of navy and gold fabrics together. Press towards the darker. Cut this strip set into 2" intervals. (8 units) Pair these together for checker board corners.

Sew a background 2" square to a green rectangle. Press to the green. Sew a green rectangle to the right side edge of the checker board corner. Press seam to green.

Lay a red square RST on a background rectangle. Draw a diagonal line and stitch on line.

Trim and press. Place another square on the other end like before mark the diagonal in the same direction. Make 4 in one direction and 4 in the opposite direction as shown below in the diagram.



Sew opposites together; refer to the block drawing above. Now, piece the block row by row, and then by sewing the rows together to make the block.
