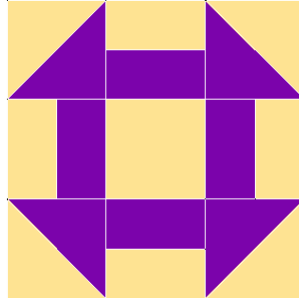




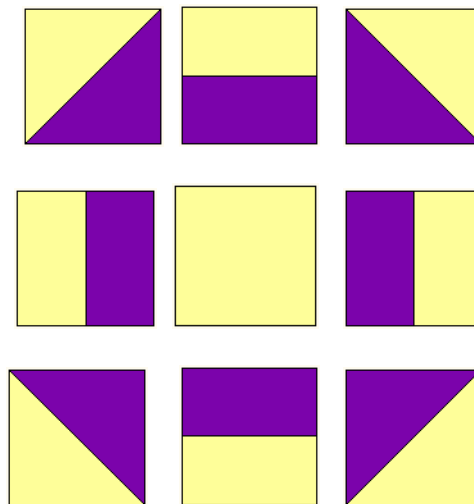
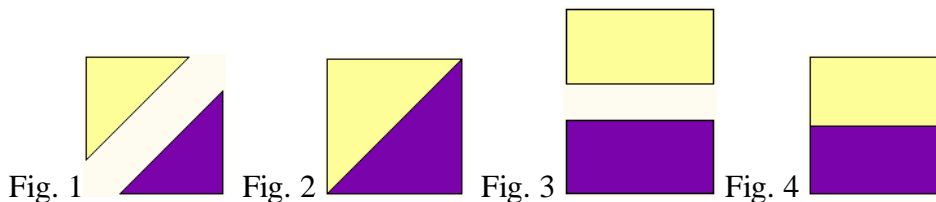
A Free 6" Block Pattern For You! ENJOY!



From background fabric: Cut 2- $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut these squares once on the diagonal for 4 triangles. Cut 4- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pes., and 1- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sq.

From focus fabric: Cut 2- $2\frac{7}{8}$ " sq., cut squares on the diagonal once for 4 triangles, and 4- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pes.

Make 4 units as follows; sew 4 background triangles to 4 focus fabric triangles. See figures 1 and 2. Make 4 units as follows; sew each of the four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " of background fabric to the same size piece of focus fabric. Fig. 3 and 4. Lay out these units in rows, placing the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sq of background fabric in the center of row 2, stitch these units together in rows then sew the rows together to finish the block.



This patchwork block is called Double Monkey Wrench. Although different color variations exist with other names.

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
