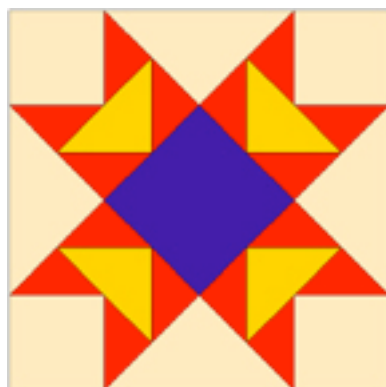


Block of the Month –Northumberland Star- 2004



Cutting Instructions:

From background fabric: cut 4- 3" x 3" squares (corner squares); 1- 7" x 7" square, cut this square on the diagonal twice to make 4 quarter-square triangles (side setting triangles).

From gold fabric: cut 4- 2 5/8" x 4" rectangles (flying geese units)

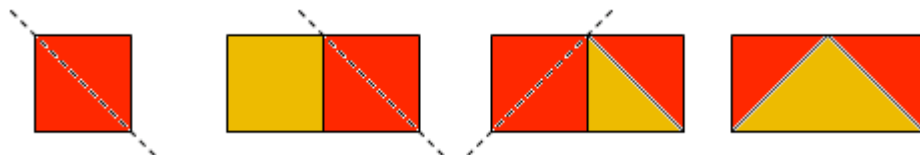
From red fabric: cut 4- 3" squares cut once on the diagonal to make 8 half-square triangles (square and triangle units); 8- 2 5/8" squares (flying geese units)

From blue fabric: 1- 4" square (center square)

Square and Triangle Units: Add a red triangle to one side of a 3" square, press, then add a second triangle to the other side as shown below. Make 4 units.



Flying Geese Units: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of red 2 5/8" squares. Place RST on one end of the background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim away excess. Repeat for the other end. Make 4 units. Assemble block as shown above.
