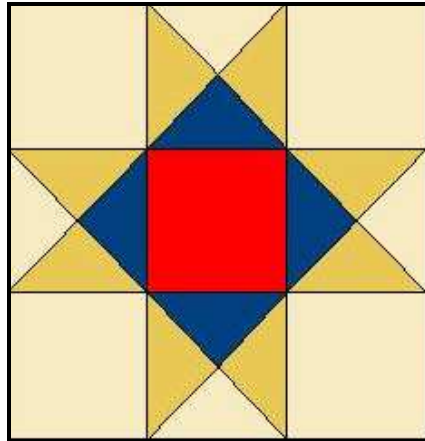


Block of the Month - Ohio Star



Cutting Instructions:

From Background Fabric: Cut 4 squares $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ Cut 1 square $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$, cut twice diagonally to make quarter-square triangles- yields 4.

From Red Print: Cut 1 square $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$

From Blue Fabric: Cut 1 square $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$, cut twice diagonally to make quarter-square triangles- yields 4.

From Gold Fabric: Cut 2 squares $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$, cut twice diagonally to make quarter-square triangles- yields 4.

Make 4 units as follows: Sew one gold triangle to one background triangle. Sew one gold triangle to one blue triangle. Match seams to finish unit.

Row 1- Background block- One unit (blue triangle pointing up)- Background block

Row 2- One unit (blue triangle pointing left) - Red square- One unit (blue triangle pointing right)

Row 3- Background block- One unit (blue triangle pointing down)- Background block

Sew rows together to make Ohio Star Block.
